Vocational Classes

Vocational classes are graded following the Australian qualification guidelines to ensure that your child is working towards tangible standards in techniques and creative skills. Here is brief overview of each style of class we offer:

Classical Ballet

Our signature class incorporating the Royal Academy of Dance (R.A.D) Syllabus with a combination modern and traditional classical terminology, techniques, and themes. Creativity is encouraged through group settings as each level progresses. Music, acting, and dance come together with an experience that makes ballet so popular with dancers worldwide.

Jazz

Jazz has evolved with music influence from 50's all the way through to the current day. Jazz technique derives from ballet, and adds elements of upbeat energy, moves and themes. Jazz class explores rock n' roll, disco, pop, and much more.

Pre-Pointe & Pointe

Our pointe training program focuses on careful, progressive development with the support of Dance Physio programs to ensure strong, safe muscle development. Prior to beginning pointe work, each student must undergo a medical check with a dance physiotherapist to ensure they are physically ready for this advanced stage of training.

Lyrical/Contemporary

A more modern interpretation of ballet that explores expressive movement with a contemporary slant on energy and aesthetics. Lyrical & contemporary draws upon ballet techniques and adds a more experimental aspect to performance works.

Tap

Tap is popular for its fun and percussive rhythms with feet. Influenced from Hollywood Tap greats such as Shirley Temple, Fred Astaire & Gene Kelly tap has developed styles including Musical Theatre & street tap

Repertoire & Production

Study the classics such as Giselle, Nutcracker, West Side Story as well as modern stories like Tangled, Frozen, and Mary Poppins. Focus is on lead and supporting role choreography with training in production and stage management for a comprehensive understanding of Theatre Arts.

ENROLMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **What's Not Included:** Your monthly fee does not cover external events, such as EOY Theatre Tickets, Holiday Programs.
- **GST:** All fees are inclusive of GST.
- **Payment Schedule:** Monthly instalments are direct debited on the 1st of each month, from February to November.
- **Missed Classes:** No refunds are given for missed classes. Instead, students can arrange a "make-up" class via the parent portal.
- **Pro-Rata Payments:** New students enrolling during the term/month will be required to pay a pro-rata monthly instalment (this covers other inclusions at a reduced rate).
- **Payment Method:** Payments via direct debit from your nominated bank account or credit card, cash or bank transfer.
- **Payment Charges:** No gateway payment charges will apply, except in the case of rejected or bounced payments.
- **Enrolment Roll-Over:** Enrolment automatically rolls over each month unless cancelled in writing 28 days in advance.
- **Class Changes/Cancellations:** Any changes or cancellations of classes must be submitted in writing to office@dancestruck.com. A 28-day cancellation notice is required.
